- NO garbage NO toys NO ceramics NO plastic bags NO plastic tubes NO candy or Food wrappers**
- NO Styrofoam of any kind NO plastic shrink wrap NO plastic food containers marked "compostable" or "PLA"**
- NO bubble wrap or envelopes with bubble wrap inside**

FOOD & BEVERAGE CARTONS



Products commonly packaged in cartons include:

- ♻️ Milk (dairy, soy, almond)
- ♻️ Juice
- ♻️ Soup broth, and wine
- ♻️ Protein drinks and juice boxes
- ♻️ Ice cream and frozen yogurt

ALUMINUM CANS & FOIL



Remove as much residue as possible

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



- ♻️ Flatten and cut cardboard into pieces no larger than 2ft. x 2ft.
- ♻️ Only broken down boxes

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES & CATALOGS



PLASTICS



Acceptable Plastics are rigid bottles, jugs, cups, tubs, trays and containers marked with the numbers 1 through 7 and include:

- ♻️ Soda, water and shampoo bottles
- ♻️ Milk, detergent and cat litter jugs
- ♻️ Yogurt, sour cream, cottage cheese and butter tubs
- ♻️ Peanut butter and mayonnaise jars
- ♻️ "To-Go" plastic drinking cups
- ♻️ Plastic trays like those used for microwave dinners
- ♻️ "Clamshell" containers like those used to package berries and baked goods

PAPERBOARD



- ♻️ Cereal and soda boxes, paper towel rolls, paper egg cartons, etc.
- ♻️ Flatten all paperboard

PHONE BOOKS



- ♻️ Remove and discard magnets

STEEL CANS



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



- ♻️ Food and Beverage glass only
- ♻️ Large metal lids can be recycled, but must be removed from bottle or jar

OFFICE PAPER & JUNK MAIL



- ♻️ Separate shredded paper from other paper

PAPER BAGS



- ♻️ Cereal and soda boxes, paper towel rolls, paper egg cartons, etc.
