PLEASE REMEMBER TO GET YOUR DOG LICENSE RENEWED, OR IF YOU ARE NEW IN TOWN TO HAVE YOUR DOG LICENSED. IF YOUR DOG IS 6 MONTHS OF AGE OR OVER, THEY NEED TO BE LICENSED. YOUR LICENSES EXPIRE ON THE 31ST OF DECEMBER OF EVERY YEAR.

YOU NEED TO PROVIDE PROOF FROM YOUR VET THAT YOUR DOG HAS RECEIVED THEIR RABIES VACCINATIONS AND THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE RABIES. IF YOUR DOG HAS BEEN LICENSED AND THE RABIES HAVE EXPIRED DURING THE YEAR, YOU MUST BRING PROOF THAT YOUR DOGS RABIES VACCINATIONS HAVE BEEN UPDATED.

THE COST OF THE LICENSES ARE AS FOLLOWS: \$5.00 FOR A SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOG. \$10.00 IF THE DOG IS NOT FIXED.

YOUR DOG TAGS AND LICENSES CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE HANNA MARSHALS OFFICE OR TOWN HALL. PLEASE STOP BY MONDAY THRU THURSDAY AT THE MARSHALS OFFICE AND MONDAY THRU FRIDAY AT THE TOWN HALL AND WE WILL BE HAPPY TO HELP YOU.

WE NO LONGER BOARD DOGS AS PER MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL!

AS A REMINDER, WE WILL ISSUE CITATIONS FOR THOSE RESIDENTS THAT ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS TOWN ORDINANCE. A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE IS AVAILABLE FOR YOUR INSPECTION.

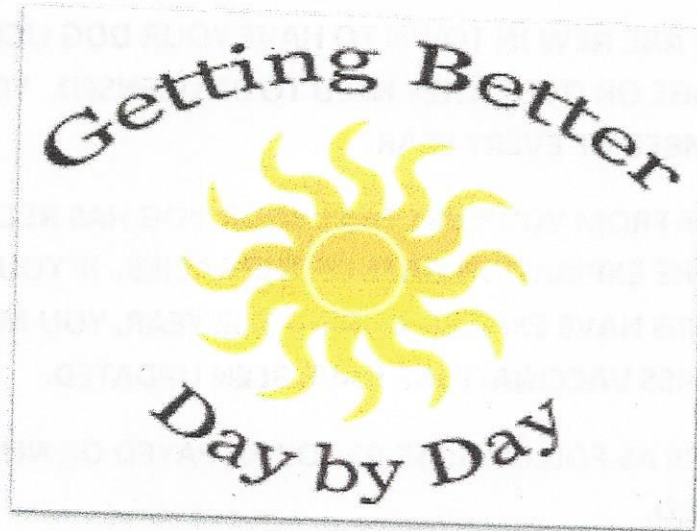
